LANCASHIRE COUNTY SAFEGUARDING LEAD

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. If you are worried, or spot signs of abuse, notice changes in behaviours or are concerned about conduct of an individual around or towards a child or an adult at risk, you have a duty to report it.

All concerns must also be reported following the escalation procedure below:

Signs to look for:

- Withdrawn
- Worried/Distressed/Upset
- Lack of participation
- Change in Usual Behaviours
- Covering up their body
- Marks/bruising
- Aggression/Violence/Outbursts
- · Coercive/Controlling/Bullying Behaviours
- Extravagance money, phones, trainers

Categories of Abuse:

- Physical
- Emotional
- Sexual
- Neglect
