

Round 2 of the Lancashire Men's KO Cup 2025

At Netherfield, Lowerhouse suffered a dramatic collapse from 105-3 to 121 all out, thanks to a stellar bowling display from Cole McConchie (3-4) and Ollie Wileman (2-8). Netherfield chased down the target comfortably, winning by seven wickets.

Fleetwood edged past Roe Green in a low-scoring thriller, chasing down 107 with just one wicket remaining. Nathan Bend played a crucial role, scoring 35 off 39 balls, while Adam Sharrocks held firm at the other end.

Appleby Eden posted 184 against Formby, but Ian Cockbain proved too strong, guiding Formby to victory with an unbeaten 78.

Ali Ross took 2-8 and then hit 43 in Clitheroe's 6 wicket win over Shaw in a 20 overs a-side game at Chatburn Road. Chasing 122 for victory, professional Madhav Kaushik hit 36 and Joe Bolton an unbeaten 24 to take Clitheroe through with ten balls to spare

Northern are also in the quarters after an away win at joint holders Prestwich. Tyler McGladdery played the anchor role with an unbeaten 56, with a stand of 85 with Alex Vincent doing the bulk of the chasing. The hosts managed 159 from the 41 overs available, Matthew Laker's nine overs costing just 18 runs and yielding two wickets.

Blackrod defeated Padiham by 44 runs. After a 72 from 100 ball contribution from Navod Paranavithana, Blackrod set 184/4, Padiham had Iftikhar Naseer 64 runs from 77 as a platform but were unable to build on this and were all out for 140.

Salesbury and Burnley both progressed via bowl-outs, with Salesbury defeating Blackpool and Burnley edging out Longridge in a sudden-death 4-3 victory.
